SNORING ISN'T SEXY

Most people think of snoring as a social annoyance. Five years ago, my snoring forced my wife "into the closet" (personally, I thought she seemed very comfy surrounded by her stuff). Then, it turns out that my snoring was a sign of a much greater problem, sleep apnea. I administered a home sleep study and sure enough, I stopped breathing for 10 seconds or more, 18 times per hour!

I sought medical advice and was told about the CPAP machine. I knew I would never use CPAP and thus started my role as a consultant with the Vermont Regional Sleep Center at Fletcher Allen Health Care. Since then I have treated my snoring/apnea and hundreds of others' by fabricating a simple oral appliance. My snoring has stopped, my apnea reduced to normal and, most important, my beautiful wife is back "in the closet"...only during waking hours!

If you or someone you know snores or does not like their CPAP machine, let me know. I would be happy to discuss my personal experience and see if an oral appliance might be an appropriate alternative.
